Apply for state and local tax exemptions. The IRS requires you to include specific language in your articles of incorporation for those intending to apply for federal tax-exempt status. This can be especially helpful if there's another organization in your community that already does something similar to what you want to .

You must make sure to include specific language stating the charitable purpose. To qualify for tax-exempt status, your organization must exist to further one of the purposes listed by the IRS, such as religious or educational purposes. Arizona, Georgia, Nebraska, Nevada, New York, and Pennsylvania all require that new

businesses publish in a newspaper before operating in that state.

Business planning involves understanding the marketplace, the market opportunity, and the competition. Once you have completed your business plan, it is time for the board to officially approve your bylaws and elect your board officers. As a non profit, you can apply for 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status at the federal level with the IRS.
