There were reports that national and border police facilitated trafficking and raped sex trafficking victims. Some victims faced hardships due to threats from the local community. Officials reported identifying 80 potential trafficking victims, but did not report how many of these victims received services.

The government undertook few efforts to protect trafficking victims during the year, the government prosecuted fewer alleged trafficking cases and convicted fewer trafficking offenders than in the previous year, and it did not identify any labor trafficking victims; therefore, Azerbaijan is placed on Tier 2 Watch List for a fifth consecutive year. Bahraini government officials indicate there is a general lack of awareness of trafficking crimes among working-level police. Greek NGOs and police report that traffickers used deception to enter into romantic relationships with Trafficking in Persons Report 2012 Benin female victims from poorer areas in countries such as Albania or Romania with the goal of forcing the victim into prostitution in Greece. Although there is no trafficking-specific legal alternative to the removal of foreign victims to countries where they may face hardship or retribution, victims often were allowed to remain in the country temporarily.
